The Shambhala Organisation has announced that applications are now open for scholarships for LGBT leaders (and future leaders) who wish to study further. There are ten R25,000 scholarships available for studies in 2017. LGBT people from all fields of study and at all levels (undergrad, post-grad or part-time) are invited to apply.

The Shambhala Organisation was established to promote and support LGBT business leaders through scholarships for further studies, coaching & mentorship to enhance performance and private equity investments in high potential entrepreneurial businesses.

Since it was launched in 2014 by founder Dale Pudney, the organisation has already awarded 18 scholarships to LGBT leaders to further their studies to help them improve their performance in the business world.

The committee will be looking at criteria including: natural leadership qualities; evidence of activism; ability to achieve great things; and the likelihood of promoting The Shambhala Organisation.

While enabling the students to study towards a career in leadership positions in various types of organisations, the recipients are also required to give back by doing community service; with recipients having personalised action plans built into their scholarship agreements.

The deadline for applications is no later than 30 November 2016.
